

## **Health and Safety**

- Why is the pipeline going to be at 1450 PSI? What is the high consequence area or blast zone for this pipeline?
- What are the blast zone distance calculations and how will emergencies be handled and by whom? Is the county EMS equipped currently to handle this? How would people be notified? What are reporting requirements/evacuation times/ etc.

## **Environmental/Cultural**

- Can you further explain what the approval process will look like for MVP Southgate? Will it need its own Environmental Impact Statement?
- What is the total water usage that will be needed for the compressor stations and in construction of the pipeline? What is that water supply? The Dan? Municipal supplies?
- Which cultural landmarks have you identified along the proposed route? There are 80 historical sites near the corridor and 20 within. What are you going to do about cemeteries along this route?
- How many public and private waterways and sources have you identified along the proposed route? What will you do to protect private springs and drinking water sources?
- Who is both financially responsible and physically responsible for any issues, problems, or failures of the pipeline on my property?

## **Jobs and Economy**

- Who has agreed to purchase gas from this pipeline? Is it all accounted for and if so- How will this Southgate expansion encourage economic development in these counties, especially considering there are existing pipelines in these counties?

## **Property Impacts**

- Why are you sending surveyors out to collect information on private property even though you don't have the permits to do so?
- Why are you using Doyle when they can't legally survey in North Carolina because they aren't licensed here, and they have had numerous complaints filed against them during the construction of the Atlantic Coast Pipeline and the Mountain Valley Pipeline? Are you instructing them to harass and manipulate landowners along the proposed route?

## **Transparency**

- What outreach have you already done to counties and municipalities along the proposed route?
- Why is the pipeline going to be at a pressure of up to 1450 psi if it's just going 70 miles to Burlington? What are the plans for expansion after Southgate?
- Why is one of the reasons for the Southgate extension is to provide North Carolina and southern Virginia with direct pipeline access to the Marcellus and Utica gas regions; given that natural gas demand in NC is flat- and the ACP is planning to come through both states?

## **Compressor Stations**

- What systems will be put in place to monitor toxic air pollutants that will be released?
- Have folks in the area of the proposed compressor station (Eden/Leaksville) been notified? Will they be notified about volatile organic compounds (VOCs) that are emitted by compressor stations and have been associated with several serious health problems, including cancers?
- Will they be made aware of the health effects associated during compressor station venting or blowdowns, including burning eyes and throat, skin irritation, headaches?
- What type of public education will be provided for surrounding residents/landowners on compressor stations?
